One of the most infamous recent examples is California, which is currently under a medical receivership because of decades-long deficiencies in the medical and mental health treatment it provided its inmates, and which is also under a court order upheld by the US Supreme Court to reduce prison overcrowding so that the unconstitutionally deficient medical

and mental health services can be remedied. This stance may also be a strategy to protect themselves if they are living in dangerous prisons.
