Contrary to much popular mythology, a fair amount of social insurance was in existence in Canada before the Depression and was extended during the s, almost entirely on a provincial basis. The decline in prices was dramatic and almost universal; especially the collapse of the wheat prices struck farmers on the Prairie Provinces.
