Americans waited for nearly three years for President Herbert Hoover to do something that might reverse the Great Depression. Such a ban is typically issued to coincide with Trump's travel to the resort.

Other states soon recognized the importance of making such additions to the Constitution. The Convention had been authorized merely to draft amendments to the Articles of Confederation but, as Madison later wrote, the delegates "with a manly confidence in their country" simply threw the Articles aside and went ahead with the consideration of a wholly new form of government. The national government should have had the power to lay whatever tariffs were necessary and to regulate commerce -but it did not. They met without resistance from the state government, and for a few days the scientific-research organizations with military overtones - heirs to such century-old bodies as the Coast and Geodetic Survey - were minor players.
